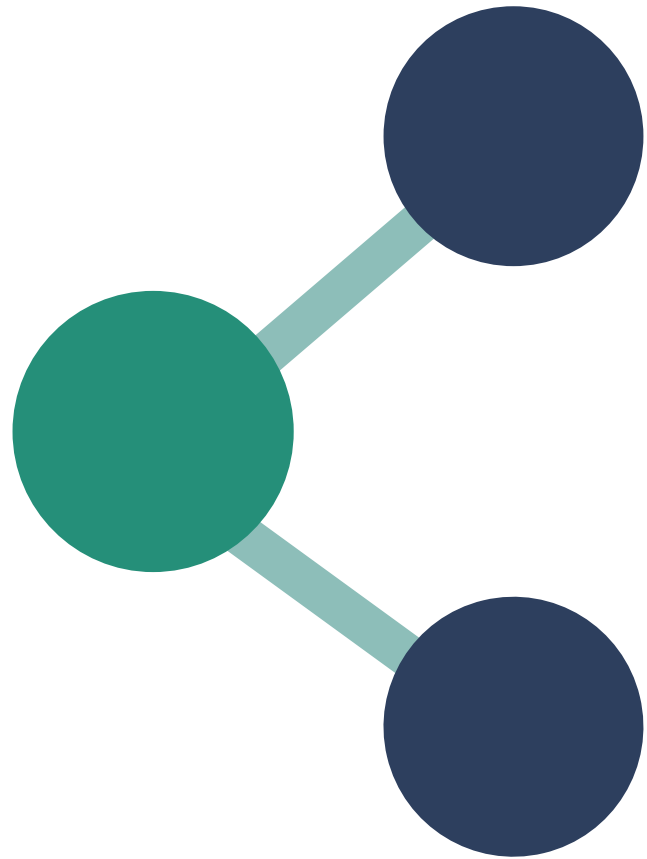
CPD POINTS - COVID-19

- All members that want to transfer accredited points need to submit their documentation by the 31st of December.
- This special arrangement is made for members that already completed the total amount of points (20 accredited points) before "lockdown" and want to transfer CPD points to 2021.
- Members need to submit their learning activity record form together with their SAPIK CPD certificates.

ARTICLE OPPORTUNITIES

- The 3rd Accredited and ethical article opportunities are available and the submission date is 27th of November.
- A grace period of 3 days after the cut-off date to submit articles are approved.
- Members can still submit articles within this timeframe but have to pay a 50% fine of the article opportunity's original price.

CPD AUDIT

- Members that were selected for the 2019 audit received their letters on the 1st of October 2020.
- Selected members should complete their learning activity record form and attach their SAPIK CPD certificates.

CPD EXEMPTION APPLICATION FORM

- This online application form is to apply for exemption of CPD points.
- The following members are allowed to apply for exemption: (If you are expecting a baby, adopting a baby or your wife is expecting a baby).
- After approval by SAPIK, members need to accumulate 15 CPD points in the year that the baby is born. (Of these 15 CPD points, 6 points must be ethics points).

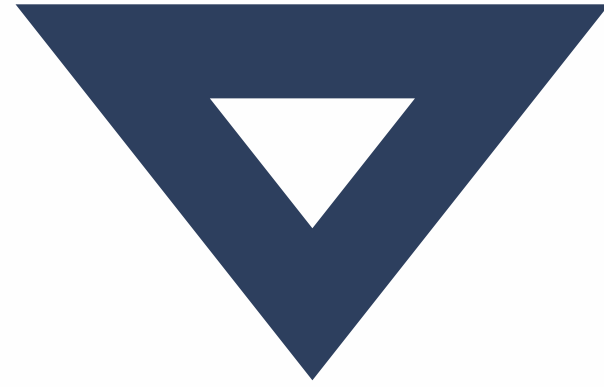
SAPIK is busy putting together a Samaritan's fund to help members that struggle to pay yearly registration fees. Funding will be done according to a specific criteria.

SAPIK got insurance on office content, electronic equipment, as well as common law liability insurance.



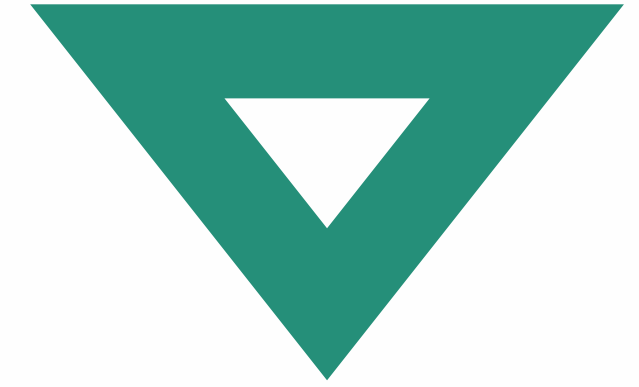

Healthy financial growth ensures that we will be able to pay attorneys to handle more complex matters in an appropriate way in the future.

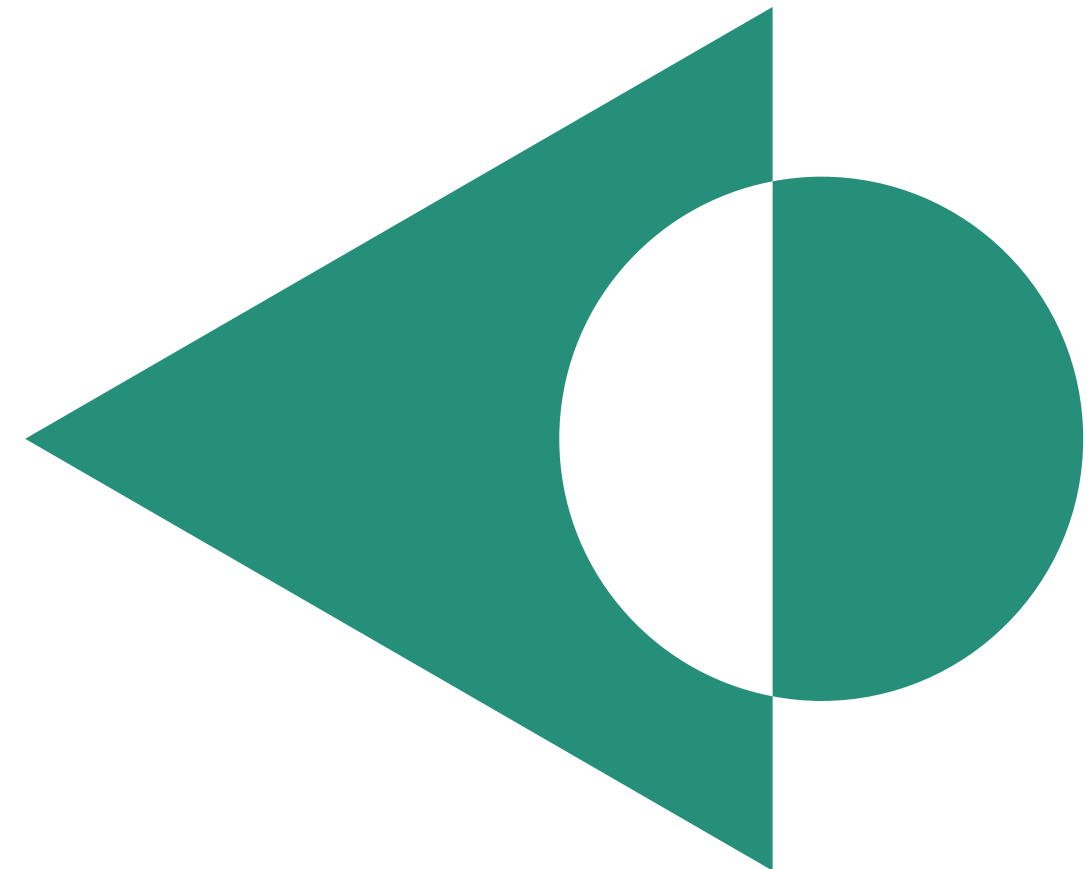
TRAINING

- We are looking forward in seeing you all again in person next year at the AGM for 2021.




Social Media Pages

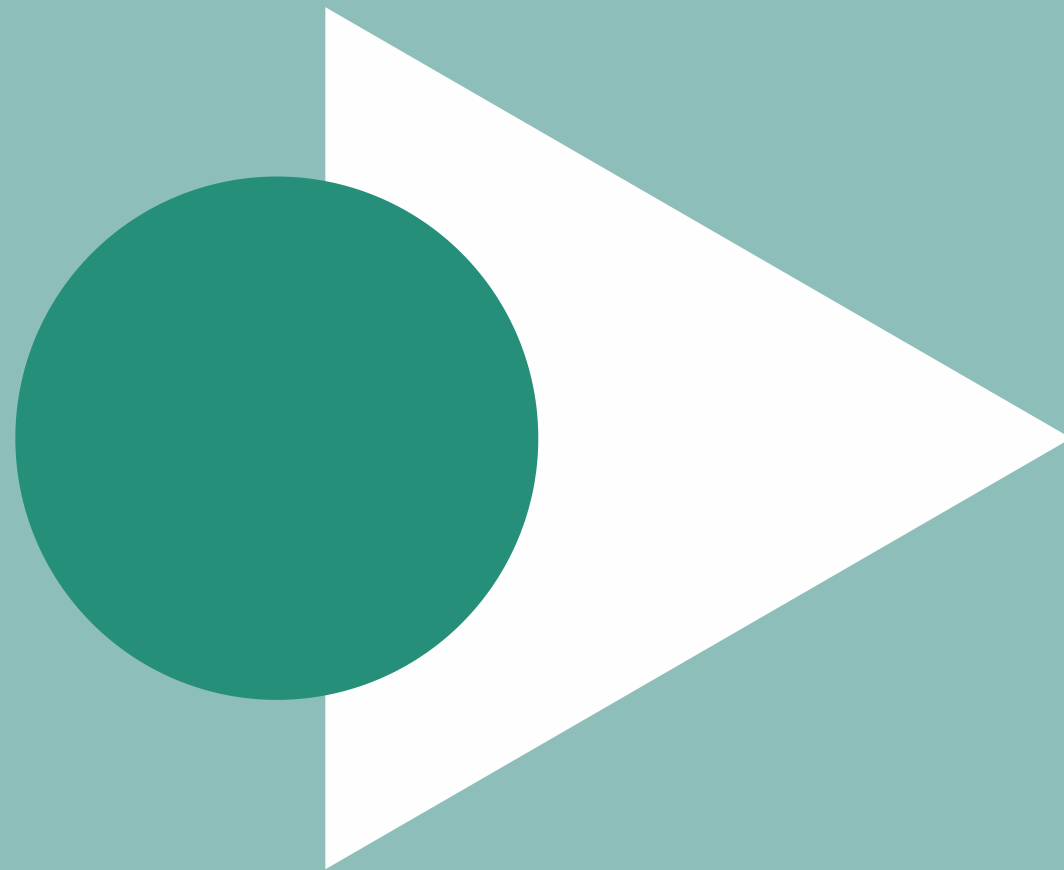
A small change was made to the practice visit evaluation criteria scoring system, where a 'yes and no' criteria was added with a 1-5 score for easier evaluation.

A new practice visit procedure has been set up for members of SAPIK that are registered, but do not practice as Kinderkineticists. These members will not be visited for a formal practice visit, but will only be audited.

A booklet was set up by the Practice Forum for new upcoming Kinderkineticists starting up their practice. This booklet has guidelines to consider when opening your practice. The booklet will be made available to all members in the next couple of days.

A short informational pamphlet was set up for members working with HPCSA professionals, highlighting the key components to remember in this type of professional relationship. The pamphlet will be emailed to all members in the next couple of days.

This is an optional choice.



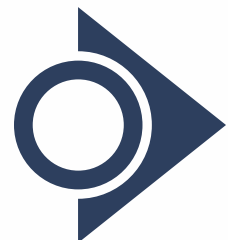
WHEN AND WHERE TO BE USED

THIS IS THE OFFICIAL LOGO OF SAPIK.

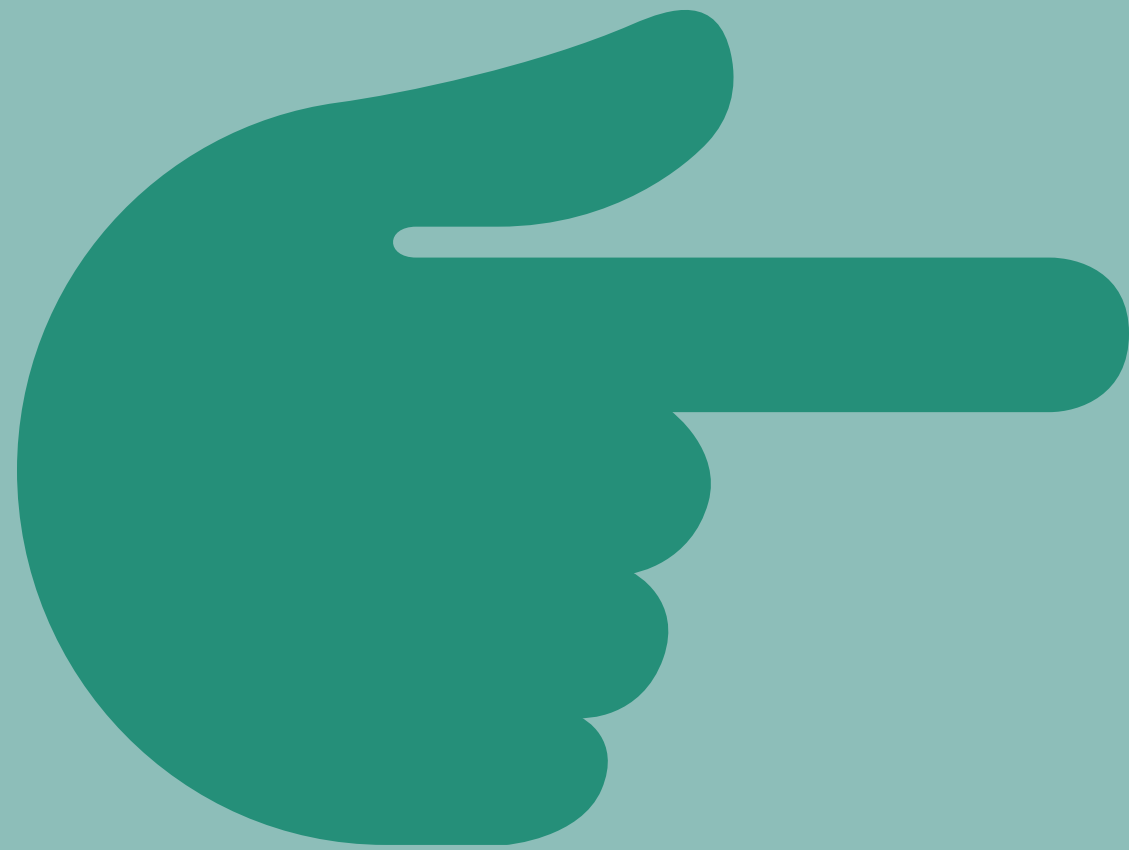
The SAPIK logo must appear on all business cards, pamphlets, banners, boards, and official reports and documents of the practice.
